## *PARMA ARENA GROOMER® INFORMATION*

The PARMA Arena Groomer® has been proven in arenas and on tracks for all events that require good footing. Its ability to prepare your base, as well as the top surface, in one pass can improve the performance of your horse and save stress on his legs at the same time. The unit uses vibrating "S" tines that can be set to your desired digging depth to leave a well prepared base. Following the tines is a leveling bar that will shave off high spots and carry dirt to fill holes as you pass over the arena. To the rear of the machine is a roller that conditions the surface, and also gauges the depth of the tines, to leave a uniform finish on your arena. Our four standard machine sizes are listed on the enclosed brochure. Special sizes can be built on request.

This concept, though new to arenas, has been proven for years by Parma and other manufacturers in farm use to prepare seed beds for planting. The Arena Groomer® is designed especially for arena and track use. Most agricultural equipment that will do the same job as this unit is much larger and expensive. Parma Company has been a farm equipment manufacturer for many years and knows how to build machines that last.

The Arena Groomer® has been designed in a simple bolt together package that can easily be shipped by truck to any location. Assembly instructions and all parts for immediate use are included in the package.
